



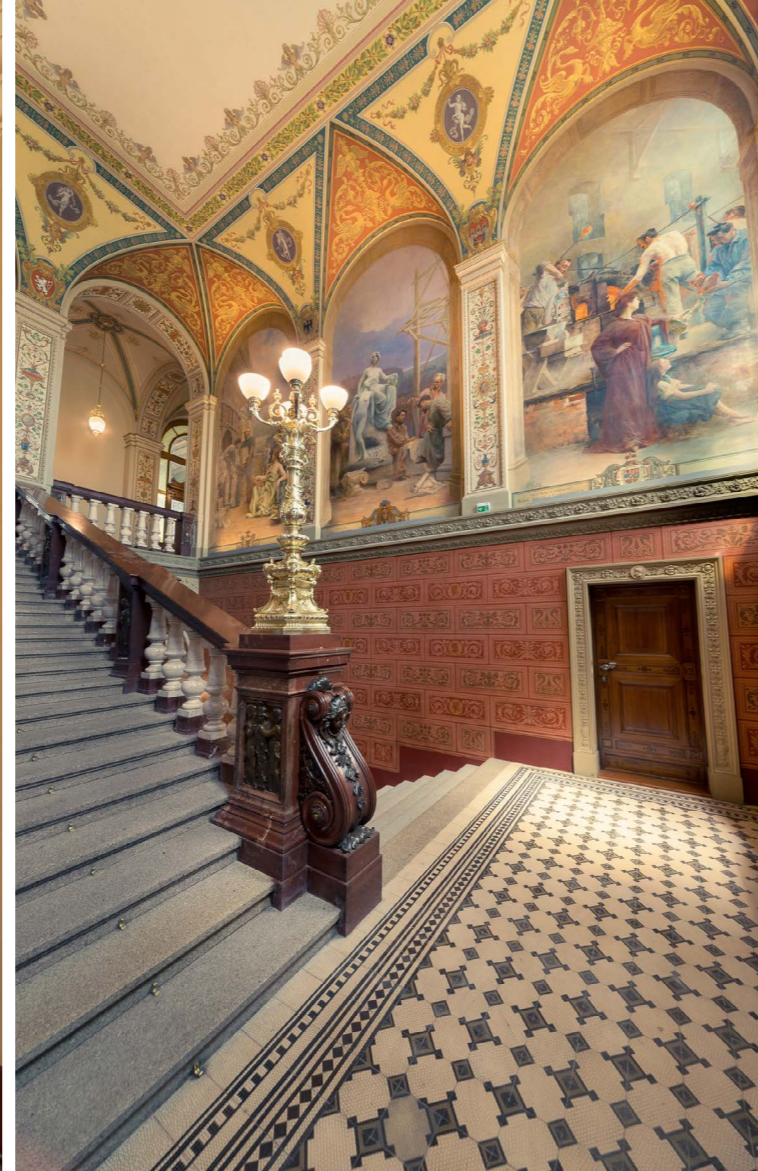

With the unique beauty of its setting, events held at the Museum of Decorative Arts in Prague are always a special occasion. Whether you're organising a conference, an art workshop, an exhibition or a glittering reception, the museum's main building in the centre of Prague will add a distinctive and elegant touch. Naturally we have contacts for catering, equipment hire, professional interpreting and lighting services, all with a proven track record. In the summer months events can be held in the museum's garden, which has been restored according to the original design from 1940 to create a green oasis in the city centre.



CONFERENCE HALL

The conference hall on the first floor of the museum is ideal for conferences, presentations, workshops, balls, theatre performances, corporate parties, etc.

The hall is equipped with a projector and screen, together with audio equipment (including wireless microphones), while conference tables, chairs and bistro tables are also available.

There will also be the option of hiring an adjacent hall (150 m²), which can be used e.g. for catering services upon agreement.

Both halls have track lighting by Etna iGuzzini. The anteroom can be used for catering or as a cloakroom, etc. There is a freight elevator serving both rooms, and parking for event organisers can be arranged in the courtyard, as can the use of the garden. Services include storage facilities and 24-hour security.

By agreement the restaurant on the ground floor, which also has a cloakroom and toilets, can be used during an event.

The hall measures 201 m².

The maximum capacity of the multifunctional hall is:

- auditorium seating: 190 persons
- school seating: 60 persons
- U-shaped seating: 50 persons



TRANSVERSE HALL

It is located on the 1st floor of the museum and is adjacent to the conference hall. It is therefore the ideal place for a lavish banquet or a separate room for a workshop etc. Access to the hall via the conference hall.

There is no sound system in the hall, only Etna iGuzzini strip lighting. We offer equipment with conference tables, chairs and bistro tables.

The hall has an area of 160 m².

The maximum capacity of the hall is:

- auditorium seating: up to 130 people
- school setting: aprox. 50 people



LECTURE HALL

The lecture hall fully accessible to wheelchairs on the ground floor of the museum is suitable for educational events, presentations, workshops, etc.

We only rent it together with the conference hall on the first floor.

The lecture hall is fully accessible to wheelchair, it is equipped with a projector and screen, together with audio equipment (including wireless microphones), while optional furnishings include conference tables, chairs and bistro tables.

The lecture hall measures 73 m².

The maximum capacity of the lecture hall is:

- auditorium seating: 60 persons
- school seating: 30 persons





MUSEUM GARDEN

The garden at the Museum of Decorative Arts was designed by Augusta Machoňová-Müllerová and Ladislav Machoň for a competition held as part of the New Architecture exhibition in 1940.

The garden includes a terrace with outdoor seating for a restaurant inside the museum building.

The garden can be hired in conjunction with an event in the conference hall, and is ideal for an afternoon or evening programme. The garden is also a beautiful setting for a wedding, a chamber concert in the pavilion, or a celebratory picnic.

The garden measures approximately 400 m². The maximum capacity of the garden is approximately 200 persons.

Facilities:

- wheelchair access
- portable audio equipment, microphones
- seating beneath a pergola
- pavilion





RESTAURANT TURQUOISE

Located on the museum's ground floor, Turquoise specialises in Mediterranean cuisine. Ingredients and spices are imported from Israel and other countries of the Mediterranean.

The restaurant has two rooms. Catering services are also available.

Total area measures 150 m².

Maximum capacity:
the restaurant seats 85 persons inside, with standing room for an additional 120 persons. There is outside seating for 50 persons.

Facilities:

- wheelchair access
- pavilion with a roof
